OBJECTIVE

Create an even circle using equal amount of foliage in each bunch.

Tip; Lay out all your bunches before attaching to make sure they cover the moss.

HELLO AND WELCOME TO YOUR WREATH KIT!

INCLUDED IN YOUR WREATH KIT

- Fresh foliage; Ivy, blue spruce and a mix of textured foliage.
 - Dried orange slices
 - Pine cones
 - Cinnamon sticks
- 1x copper wreath ring
 - 1 bag on moss
 - 1 x reel wire
- 1 x straw bow for decoration

OTHER TOOLS NEEDED/ RECCOMENDED

- Gardening or rubber gloves (When handling foliage)
 - Scissors or secateurs
- Water spray bottle (For misting moss and foliage)

WREATH MAKING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1; Unpack your materials, laying all the fresh foliage out and leave for 30 soaking in a bucket of water, to allow water absorption. If moss is dry soak that too. 😊

Step 2; Using the binding wire, find the end and attach the wire to the copper wreath by bending it around the outer circle.

Step 3; Empty the moss out of the bag (It will be wet and messy), gather the moss into sausage shaped equal pieces, making sure you have enough to cover the space between the two copper rings.

Using the bind wire, secure the moss in place by feeding the bind wire through the center of the hoop and around to the outer edge, looping the wire one way, securing and adding the moss as you go.

Once you have secured the moss all the way around, go back around with the bind wire, to tidy up and loose bits. Once happy the moss is secure, cut the wire and bend the end around a inner or outer part of the hoop to secure in place.

WREATH MAKING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 4; Using the foliage, equally make small groups of mixed pieces to create small handheld posies. Roughly 15- 20cm in length. Place the bunches around the wreath to make sure they overlap each other and cover the moss.

Step 5; Attach the bind wire to the center ring, place one bunch of foliage onto the moss with the stalks on the moss, using the bind wire, repeat the method of winding the wire to secure the stalks in place. (Not on the foliage).

Step 6; Repeat the process by layering the foliage and securing the stalks all the way around. Laying the next piece on top to cover the stalks in a clockwise direction.

Step 7; When done, cut and secure the wire in place. If you have gaps you can add pieces in by sliding in foliage to sections that need more.

Step 8; Using the bind wire, you can attach the decorations.

- The whole oranges, cut a length of binding wire and push it through the center of the orange and out the other side, once done, push the two pieces of wire through the foliage and all the way through the moss, secure then at the back of the wreath by twisting the bind wire tight.
- Use the bind wire to attach the other decorations using the same method, by piecing the item or winding it around the item. Items such as the cinnamon can be bunched into groups of 3's.

Step 9; Create a bow and attach to the wreath with bind wire. And also add a hoop at the top to hang the wreath. Or use your own piece of nice ribbon ☺
